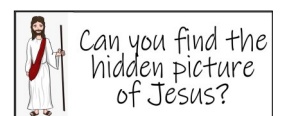

My dear friends at St. Elizabeth's:

Happy Easter! He is Risen. Alleluia!!

Today we come together to celebrate the most extraordinary event in history—the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. 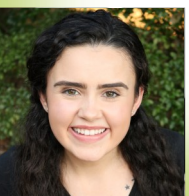
