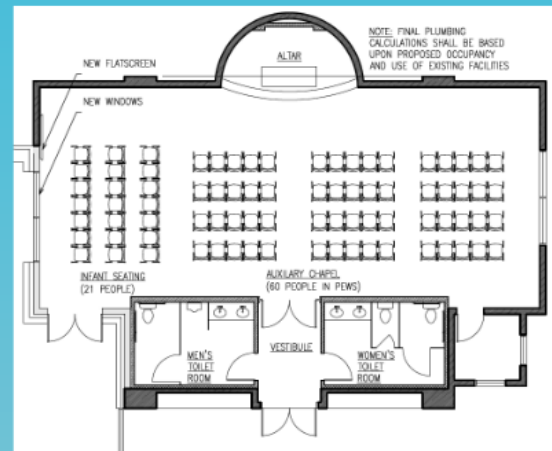

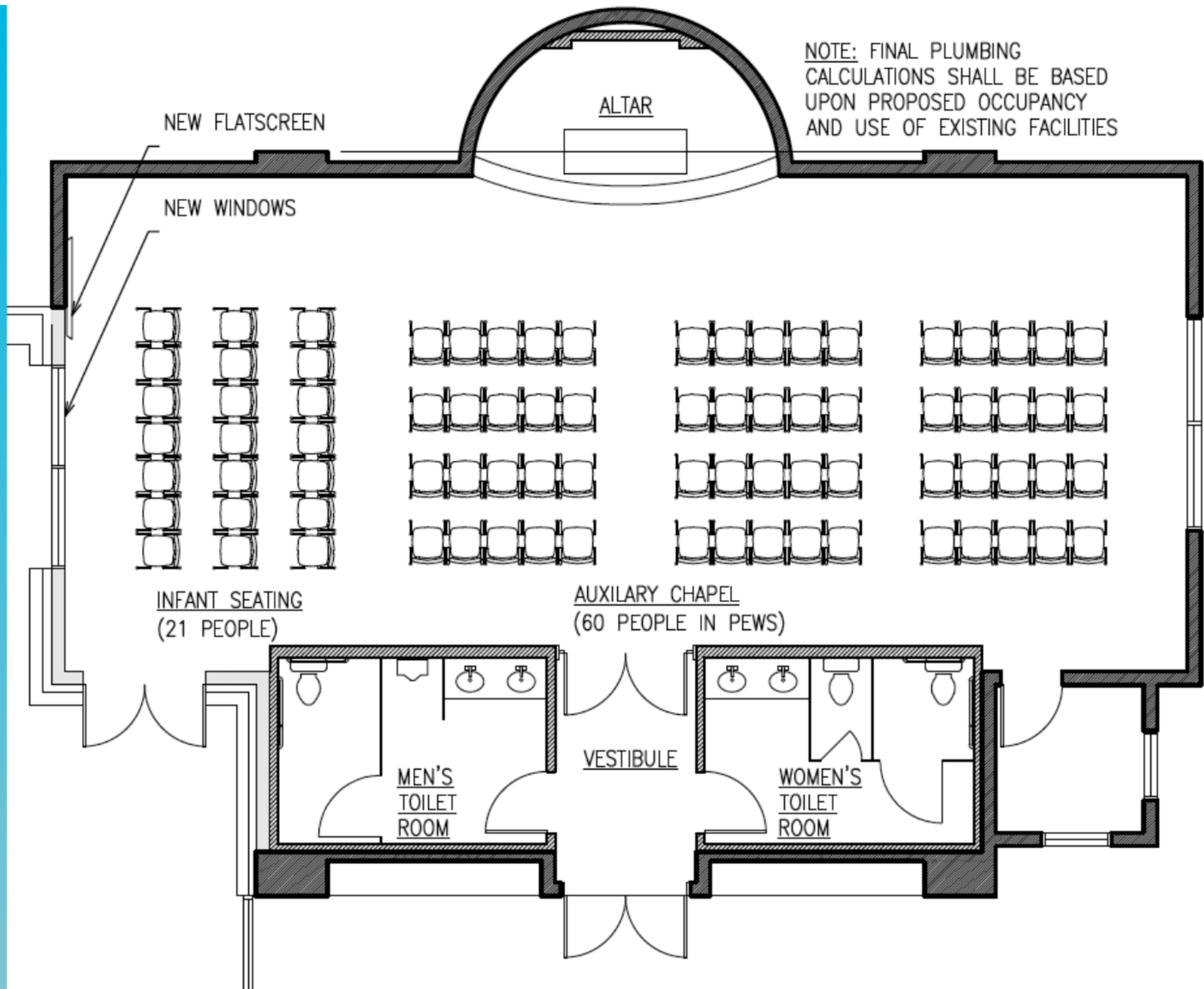
1. Questions about Capital Campaign
