



WORKS OF MERCY

Service must be rooted in the **Works of Mercy**, from Matthew's Gospel, where Jesus calls us to serve Him by caring for others. **Corporal Works of Mercy** meet physical needs: feeding the hungry, visiting the sick, helping the poor and elderly. **Spiritual Works of Mercy** feed the soul: teaching the faith and participating in the Church's liturgy (e.g., altar serving, choir).

Only certain types of service qualify. Activities like summer rec camps, cleaning litter or working with animals do **not count unless** they directly serve those who are vulnerable or in need. Please use the **pre-approved list below** or contact a Confirmation team member before choosing a different activity. Complete at least 10 hours of approved service and log them in **MobileServe by April 1st**.
