

## Emergency Disaster Fund—Second Collection

In light of the recent devastation caused by Hurricane Fiona and Hurricane Ian, Bishop Paul J. Funds also will be used by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops for pastoral and reconstruction needs of the Church in the affected areas.
