Grief Support

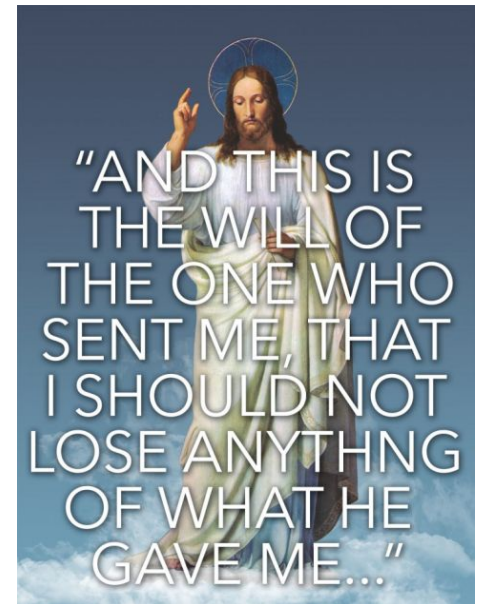
