TO KNEEL OR NOT TO KNEEL / SACRED SILENCE:

The new instruction says that only a priest, deacon or instituted acolyte is to clean the sacred vessels after Communion or after Mass. Other Eucharistic ministers or Mass servers are not permitted to do so. Under the 1975 instruction, it had become common practice in many US parishes for lay ministers of the Eucharist to cleanse the vessels.

...during the period of sacred silence...after the distribution of Holy Communion. 26 This period of sacred silence should begin as soon as the distribution of Holy Communion has been completed. 27 At this point the faithful may sit or kneel. The faithful are not required to kneel or stand during the purification of vessels, or until the reposition of the Blessed Sacrament.

"the singing [of the Communion song] is continued for as long as the Sacrament is being administered to the faithful." "The period of sacred silence would seem to begin, therefore, once all have received Holy Communion; hence the appropriate posture of the faithful during the distribution of Holy Communion is standing." 


Pew Buddies

Have you received text messages, emails or messages through Facebook Messenger from someone claiming to be Fr. Bryan asking for money or gift cards indicating it's an emergency? Don't give. It's not your pastor. It's a scam.

Over the years, several people all throughout the U.S. have been targeted by these fraudsters. They are probably using information found on our church website on in our online parish bulletins to trick parish members into parting with their cash. Sometimes they'll even go so far as to include a priest's profile picture, captured from Facebook or another online source, to make their correspondence appear more authentic.

Your pastor will never contact a parishioner directly with an emergency request for cash or gift cards. Messages asking parishioners to help fulfill a need would come through the parish's official communication channels or be accomplished through a collection approved by the diocese. If you are not sure about a text or email you've received, do not engage, click on links or respond to it. Call the parish office right away to notify a staff member.
