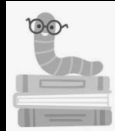

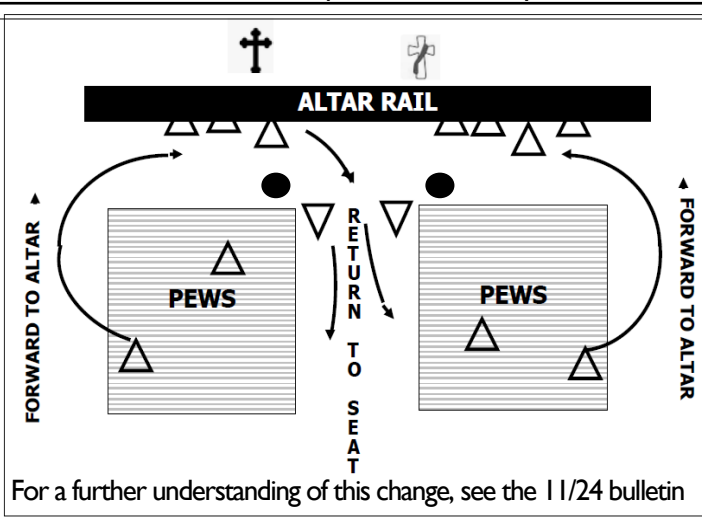

RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

Beginning with the first weekend of Advent on Nov 30/Dec 1, the reception of Holy Communion is being redirected as shown below. You will leave your pews from the side aisles and proceed to the front of the church, take a place at the altar rail by either standing or kneeling as you are able, receive the consecrated host either on the tongue or in the palm of your hand, and return to your seat by way of the center aisle. In the spring, when the cup of His blood is reintroduced for reception under both species, you are welcome to receive the consecrated wine offered on either side of the front pews indicated by the ●.
