
* The building fund was collected in the early 2000's for a new church. Changing demographics postponed the project indefinitely and since building a new church here is not viable in the foreseeable future, the archdiocese allowed these funds to be used for the new chapel and renovations in the existing church. These funds could not be used for operations and maintenance.

Analysis

We continue to focus on our youth, and in response to our parish survey, we have focused on improvements to the worship experience. The new chapel was built, the church was renovated, and ministers have been hired to focus on music and liturgy.


Expenses exceeded income, forcing us to dip into savings to cover operating expenses. Our large campus and facilities are aging and require more maintenance. As we have all seen in our personal finances, things are more expensive. The budget for our fiscal year (2025/26) that started on July 1st has been adjusted to balance projected expenses with projected income.

Most importantly, we want to continue to make St Michaels better and continue to support the improvements we started. If every parishioner could increase their monthly donation by 10%, we would easily make up the deficit.


