A Letter from Father Tom

Dear Parish Family,

The Exaltation of the Cross and Christian stewardship are deeply connected through themes of sacrifice, love, responsibility, and the call to live out the Gospel in everyday life. The Cross is the ultimate act of stewardship. Jesus gave His whole self—His time, energy, life—for the mission of salvation. It is the perfect model of self-giving love and obedience to the Father's will. Stewardship is a response to the Cross. We are called to imitate Christ's generosity by giving ourselves for the sake of others. Our stewardship flows from the gratitude we have for Christ's sacrifice. Bearing the Cross is a part of Christian Stewardship. Stewardship isn't just about giving resource. It is about offering our lives in service, even when it's difficult. This can mean enduring hardship with faith, working for justice, or caring for the poor. Just as the Cross transformed suffering into victory, our sacrifices in stewardship bring about new life in others and ourselves.

On the Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross, consider:

- How can I offer my time, talent and treasure in a way that reflects the sacrifice of Christ?
- Am I willing to embrace the crosses in my life as part of my mission of steward?
- Do I see generosity and service as ways to "lift high the Cross" in the world?




