



Dear Parish Family,

One of the most shocking parts of today's parable is the way the rich man, even in the afterlife, speaks of the poor man as a servant who is supposed to do his bidding: "Send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue." "Woe to the complacent in Zion," the prophet says. That complacency is not only a refusal to share material goods—it is a self-obsession, a total ignoring of someone, a giving-up on another as unworthy to exist except if he or she is useful to us. We are called to "pursue righteousness, devotion, faith, love, patience, and gentleness." "The King of kings and Lord of lords" loves us and suffered for us, so that we can in turn love and care for the poor, needy, and burdened in our life.


