To St. Michael's Parish,

After much discussion and deliberation, Boy Scout Troop 324 will not recharter in 2026. Changing times and declining membership have influenced this decision. Begun in 1964, this ends a spectacular run of 62 years of Scouting at St. Michael's Catholic Church. The partnership of St. Michael's Catholic Church and the Boy Scouts of America to use Scouting as part of its youth ministry program has proved to be most fruitful. During this time, hundreds of boys enjoyed the Scouting program, which teaches character development, citizenship training, and physical fitness. 144 boys earned the rank of Eagle Scout, and over 400 religious emblems were earned in both Cub Scout Pack 324 and Boy Scout Troop 324.



This is not the end of Scouting. Current youth still participating in the program will be transferring to another active Troop in the area to continue their journey through the Scouting program.

Scouts, both past and present, want to thank St. Michael's Catholic Church (religious and lay) for their long-term support. We also want to thank Knights of Columbus Council #6812 for their long-term support. Moving forward, exciting recollections and the fondest of memories will be the order of the day.




