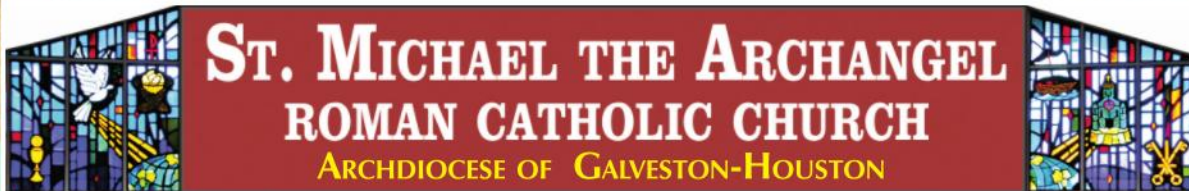

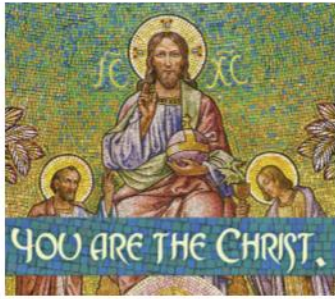

Leah Libresco grew up as an atheist. When she went to college, she picked a fight with the most interesting wrong people she could find at Yale: the Catholics. After a lot of reading, arguing, and writing, she wound up changing her own mind and converting. Her first book, *Arriving at Amen: Seven Catholic Prayers that Even I Can Answer* explains her conversion, and the challenge of learning faith as a foreign language. Her second, *Building the Benedict Option: A Guide to Gathering Two or Three Together in His Name*, is a guide to creating thick Christian community. Her writing has appeared in *FiveThirtyEight*, *The Washington Post*, *Commonweal*, *First Things*, and *The American Interest*.
