



After a lot of reading, arguing, and writing, she wound up changing her own mind and converting. Her first book, Arriving at Amen: Seven Catholic Prayers that Even I Can Answer explains her conversion, and the challenge of learning faith as a foreign language. Her second, Building the Benedict Option: A Guide to Gathering Two or Three Together in His Name, is a guide to creating thick Christian community. Her writing has appeared in FiveThirtyEight, The Washington Post, Commonweal, First Things, and The American Interest.
