TAKE THE TRAINING ON THE VIRTUS SITE. The training consists of 3 vignette style training videos that is approximately 60 minutes and will include a criminal background check that must be completed. These trainings are available in English and Spanish. We will no longer offer live trainings, all Safe Environment trainings will only be available online.

- All new employees and volunteers will complete the Safe Haven online training program instead of VIRTUS PGC training. The turnaround time for approval may be approximately two weeks or less.
- All individuals must complete the training and complete a background check prior to the start of employment and/or volunteer service.
- The 5-year anniversary date is still in place, individuals who recently attended VIRTUS will not be due to complete refresher trainings until they have met their 5-year anniversary date.

As the 5-year anniversary date is met, individuals will need to log into CMGConnect with their previous personal VIRTUS user id and 1234 as the password. Once the individual logs into their CMGConnect account, they will be able to change their PASSWORD.

Last year alone the Texas Education Agency reports over 400 accusations of sexual misconduct between adults and students. But let's be clear: it is especially evil when those purporting to follow in the footsteps of the Apostles and represent Christ in our midst act in such a vile way against the children of God.

As a result of the actions of a few, we face a terrible crisis that cries out for a widespread response of saintly behavior. When this list of "credibly accused" clergy is published, please take note how most of the incidents were decades ago. The very public case of Cardinal McCarrick is troubling, and we must find ways to understand how this happened and how to help ensure a similar case will not be repeated.

Also, be very careful of simple answers to a complex problem. There are some well-funded web sites that look only at the bad side of an issue.

I believe that those who bring the allegations do so with a firm belief that the memories of incidents are accurate and are brought forth with sincerity. Also remember that one is innocent until proven guilty. We can fall into the trap of the sin of calumny or detraction by speaking without knowledge of all the facts. Reputations are very difficult to restore when allegations prove to be unfounded and sometimes the accused never recovers. Let us keep in mind and prayer the impact to the lives of victims and the accused as we are called to be a community of healing.
