Dear Parish Family,

Today our Archdiocese of Houston-Galveston and throughout the world celebrate **World Mission Sunday**. What does it mean to us.....and to the world? First of all, each of us who is baptized, shares in Jesus' mission to evangelize all nations and peoples. Many of our brothers and sisters have responded to this call to evangelize people in remote villages and city barrios, children, the elderly, the refugees, the sick, the orphans, and the poorest of the world. These missionaries leave their homes and families and travel to distant lands so that people can hear the Good News of Jesus. 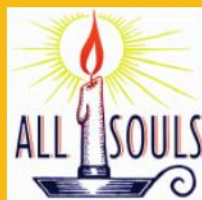

Please read the following carefully:

Safe Haven training consists of 3 vignette style training videos that is approximately 60 minutes and will include a criminal background check that must be completed. These trainings are available in English and Spanish. *All Safe Environment trainings will only be available online.*

- **All volunteers** will complete the Safe Haven online training program. The turnaround time for approval is approximately two weeks.
- **All volunteers** must complete the training and complete a background check prior to the start of volunteer service.
- A refresher training is required every 5 years.

As the 5-year anniversary date is met, you will need to log into CMGConnect with your previous personal VIRTUS user id and **1234** as the password. **Once you have logged in to CMGConnect account, you will be able to change your PASSWORD.**

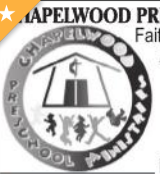
