





THANK YOU to all who volunteer here at St. Michael.

Please read the following carefully:

Safe Haven training consists of 3 vignette style training videos that is approximately 60 minutes and will include a criminal background check that must be completed. These trainings are available in English and Spanish. *All Safe Environment trainings will only be available online.* 

- **All volunteers** will complete the Safe Haven online training program. The turnaround time for approval is approximately two weeks.
- All volunteers must complete the training and complete a background check prior to the start of
  volunteer service.
- A refresher training is required every 5 years.

As the 5-year anniversary date is met, you will need to log into CMGConnect with your previous personal VIRTUS user id and 1234 as the password. Once you have logged in to CMGConnect account, you will be able to change your PASSWORD.


