THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT

The church traditionally designates the 3rd Sunday of Advent as Gaudete Sunday or Rejoice Sunday. We light the rose colored candle of our Advent Wreath and today is also one of the two days in the year that encourages us to use rose colored vestments in our liturgy. What is the significance? It is simply telling us that we are now more than halfway through the short season of Advent and the great feast of Christmas will soon be here. As we approach this great feast of the Incarnation we are asked to intensify our joy, to heighten our expectation, and convey it more. The rose colored candle and vestment are visual reminders for all of us to 'lighten up' and to 'rejoice' in the Lord always! What beautiful advice. Someone once said that Advent and Christmas are laden with anxious moments when you try to cram 15 parties, 10 shopping trips, 5 school pageants and 3 festivals in the space of 4 weeks. But it doesn't have to be that way. We have a choice.

To be dragged into the demands of the season or simply to seek the real meaning of Christmas. Jesus is the reason of the season.

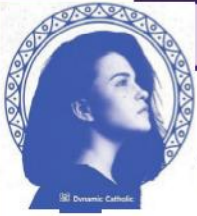
