Is someone you love unable to join us at church for Easter? Please invite them to tune in to Catholic Mass on TV or watch online anytime on Sundays at www.heartofthenations.org.

The CMG Safe Haven online training is replacing the VIRTUS training. **DO NOT ATTEMPT TO TAKE THE TRAINING ON THE VIRTUS SITE.** The training consists of 3 vignette style training videos that is approximately 60 minutes and will include a criminal background check that must be completed. These trainings are available in English and Spanish. *All Safe Environment trainings will only be available online.*

- All new volunteers will complete the Safe Haven online training program instead of VIRTUS training. The turnaround time for approval may be approximately two weeks or less.
- All individuals must complete the training and complete a background check prior to the start of volunteer service.
- A refresher training is required every 5 year.

As the 5-year anniversary date is met, individuals will need to log into CMGConnect with their previous personal VIRTUS user id and 1234 as the password. **Once the individual logs into their CMGConnect account, they will be able to change their PASSWORD.**

5TH SUNDAY OF LENT

Adult Christian Initiation (RCIA) will celebrate the Third Scrutiny at this Sunday's 11:00 Mass. As part of this ancient rite, we use the Cycle A readings that focus on *The Raising of Lazarus from the Dead* (John 11:1-44). 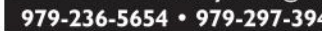
