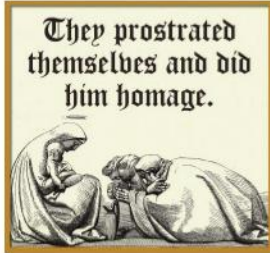

Dear Parish Family,

Today we arrive at the third major feast of the Christmas season. The first major feast was, of course, the commemoration of the birth of our Lord Jesus, then followed by the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God. Now it's the feast of the Epiphany which means Christ is manifest to the world. It always gives me a sense of awe and wonder when I gaze at the banners that are part of the Christmas decorations of our church. One banner in particular shows men traversing the desert sands. What was on their minds when they undertook this journey? What were the dangers they experienced? Did they always agree which road or path to take in that journey? That image on the banner evokes many thoughts whenever I look at it. But what those men did, taking all those risks and dangers of that journey was not something unique or strange. That encounter probably did not last a long time- just kneeling in reverence and then presenting their gifts. Then it was over. But it was enough. They had found what they were looking for.

So many stories and insights were woven around these Magi. In many ways they are like us. We too are in search and I hope and pray that we too will be guided by a star just like them.

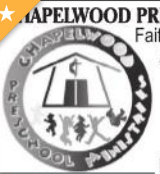
