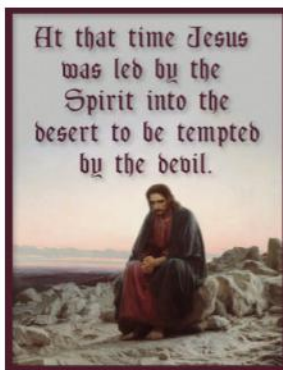

FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

Dear Parish Family,

Last Wednesday, we had ashes traced in our foreheads to remind us of our mortality and the need of penance in our lives. As an appropriate gesture, we have fasted by eating one full meal and we have abstained from eating meat during the day. Yes, the Holy Season of Lent has begun.

As with many past seasons of Lent in our lives, we ask ourselves what we will give up for Lent, what sacrifices should we make this time? After all, the things we give up, and the sacrifices we make are part of our journey with the Lord into His suffering and death on the cross. Allow me to suggest something different this year. Maybe we need to GIVE rather than to GIVE UP something. Maybe it's "living up" instead of "giving up", as in aspiring to live up to certain spiritual goals or ideals. While sacrifice remains an important Lenten theme, I believe we can greatly appreciate a fresh spiritual challenge. Try this: Pray for a stranger or someone you don't even like. Take time to write a soldier stationed overseas. Visit an elderly neighbor, the ailing and homebound. Say a rosary for peace. Pray for all those who are lost, frightened, uncertain and alone. Buy a doughnut, or a hamburger to that man standing in the street corner with a sign around his neck that said 'Hungry'. In short we begin the season of Lent by giving.

So let's plant these small seeds of sacrifice. Tend to them. Nurture them. Cultivate them. You may well be surprised at the graces that have blossomed by Easter morning!

THANK YOU to all who volunteer here at St. Michael!

Safe Haven training consists of 3 vignette style training videos that is approximately 60 minutes and will include a criminal background check that must be completed. These trainings are available in English and Spanish. *All Safe Environment trainings will only be available online.*

• **EVERYONE who is a volunteer in ANY ministry at St. Michael** is required by the Archdiocese to be trained in the SAFE HAVEN program.

• A refresher training is required every 5 years. ***DO NOT CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT TO TAKE THE REFRESHER.**

As the 5-year anniversary date is met, you will need to log into **CMGConnect** with your previous personal VIRTUS user ID and **1234** as the password. Once you have logged in to CMGConnect account, you will be able to change your PASSWORD. You must log in with **Google Chrome**, only.

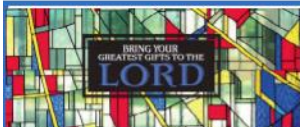
In order to keep our parish family and Our Lord safe from any harm, we have placed a keypad lock on the Adoration Chapel door. It will be locked at dark and will stay locked over the weekends. This is not intended to make the chapel "exclusive" or to keep people out. Anyone who would like after-hours access to the chapel may come to the parish office to receive the keypad code.

In order to protect your fellow parishioners as well as our Lord, we request that you do not open the door for anyone once it is locked, and also do not give the code to others. Again, the code may be obtained from the parish office.

As unfortunate as it is to have to lock the Adoration Chapel during certain hours, we have a responsibility to keep our parishioners and visitors safe and to maintain the chapel as a reverent place of prayer and honor for our Blessed Lord.

Rite of Sending for Christian Initiation (RCIA)

At Saturday's Mass, those preparing to come into the Catholic Church celebrate the *Rite of Sending*, where our parish assesses their formation and then offers blessings and prayers as we send them to go before our bishop.

Rite of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion

On Sunday afternoon, the unbaptized (Catechumens) celebrate the *Rite of Election*, which marks the end of the *Catechumenate* (period of instruction) and the beginning of the *Period of Purification and Enlightenment* (prayer and self-reflection). The Church judges their readiness to become disciples of Jesus, after which the bishop gives them his blessing. They are now *the Elect*.

Those who have already been baptized (Candidates) celebrate the *Call to Continuing Conversion*, in which the bishop greets them, asks their sponsors to affirm them, and invites them to join in full communion at Easter with the Church by listening to God's call to continuing conversion.

For both Catechumens and Candidates, this combined rite marks a period of more intense preparation as they continue their journey towards the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist) at Easter.
