- Visits in 2021 were conducted again by telephone due to the pandemic.
- "Groceries # Bags" includes food delivered during the year and Thanksgiving baskets provided to 36 families.
- "Groceries / Food Cards" includes cost of food throughout the year to supplement donations to the pantry, the cost of the Thanksgiving baskets and the food cards distributed with them.
- "Utilities" includes water, power, and natural gas.
- "Other" includes all other aid not fitting the previous categories: (gas cards, mattresses, furniture, etc.)

Funding for our work is provided by individual donations throughout the year, fundraisers conducted by other St. Michael's ministries and from our annual special collection. With the generous financial and food contributions from our parishioners, we are able to help a significant number of families in our area. 


