



#### SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION GUIDELINES FOR 1<sup>ST</sup> COMMUNION AND CONFIRMATION

- Sacramental Preparation is <u>SEPARATE AND DISTINCT</u> than regular Faith Formation Classes (i.e. your child must attend receive supplemental instruction other than the one offered on Sunday, Wednesday or at the Catholic School.)
- A separate registration form and fee is required for the sacramental processes.
- Once registered for Sacramental Formation, a calendar with sacramental sessions will be provided.
- Registration for Sacrament of Communion and / or Confirmation will be available in the month of August.
- A family meeting may take place before the sacramental process begins, to determine how the Faith Formation personnel can better assist in the individual needs each family may have.

#### FIRST RECONCILIATION & FIRST COMMUNION

#### The **CANDIDATE** (Your Child)

- Must be baptized before celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation and Eucharist.
- Must have had at least a year of formal Faith Formation (i.e. Faith Formation classes, Catholic School, or approved homeschooling) prior to this year and must be in formation the year of sacramental process.
- Must be 7 years of age or older before September 1 of the current year.
- Must be at least in the second school grade.
- Must attend all Sacramental sessions. Absences will only be excused when accompanied by a valid reason.
- Must know the required prayers.



#### CONFIRMATION FOR TEENS



# The **CANDIDATE** (Your teen) may request the Sacrament if s/he:

- Is baptized and is able to renew baptismal promises unless a grave reason suggests otherwise.
- Has received the most Holy Sacrament of the Eucharist and leads a life of faith consistent with the teachings of the Catholic Church.
- Must have had at least a year of formal Faith Formation (i.e. Faith Formation classes, Catholic School, or approved homeschooling) prior to this year.
- Must attend faith formation through St. Michael's the year of sacramental process.
- Is at least in the 10<sup>th</sup> grade level.
- Exhibits an active faith life and knowledge of the Church.
- Participates in the sacramental life of the church, especially Eucharistic liturgies- Mass.
- Commits to active involvement in the parish Confirmation catechesis.
- Responds to the call of active ministry and must know the required prayers.


