#### **FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT**

Dear Parish Family,

A few days ago, we had the ashes traced on our foreheads to remind us of our mortality and the need of penance in our lives. As an appropriate gesture, we have fasted by eating one full meal and we have abstained from eating meat during the day. Yes, the holy season of Lent has begun.

As with many past seasons of Lent of our lives, we ask ourselves, what will I give up for Lent, what sacrifices do I have to do this time? It's a good question to ask ourselves. After all, the things we give up, and the sacrifices we make is to journey with the Lord in His suffering and death on the cross. Allow me to suggest something different this year. Maybe we need to GIVE rather than GIVE UP. Maybe it's 'living up' instead of 'giving up'-as in aspiring to live up to certain spiritual goals or ideals. While sacrifice remains an important Lenten theme, I believe we can greatly appreciate a fresh spiritual challenge. Try this: Pray for a stranger or someone you don't even like. Take time to write a soldier overseas. Visit an elderly neighbor, the aging, the shut in. Light a candle for all those who are lost, frightened, uncertain or alone. Say a rosary for peace. Buy a doughnut or a hamburger for that man standing on the street corner with a sign around his neck that said "Hungry". In short, we begin this holy and penitential season by giving.

So we plant these small seeds of sacrifice. Tend them. Nurture them. Cultivate them. And then let the roots take hold. You may well be astounded at the graces that have blossomed by Easter morning!!

### RITE OF SENDING AND RITE OF ELECTION



On this First Sunday of Lent we celebrate the Rite of Sending for those preparing to come into the Catholic Church. At this rite, the sponsors that the catechumens (unbaptized) desire to join the Catholic Church and have taken their formation seriously. The parish faith community then offers their blessing and prayers as we send the participants to go before the bishop in the Rite of Election.

The Rite of Election marks the end of Catechumenate (period instruction) and the beginning of the Period of Purification and

Enlightenment (prayer and self-reflection), as the bishop acknowledges them as the "Elect of God" and gives them his blessing as they continue to the Sacraments of Initiation.

Please pray for our catechumens Felicia and her two daughters Isabella and Briell as they journey towards Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist this Easter.

#### What One Can Do

One person can do a lot of damage. As we begin Lent we remember the story of Adam and the origins of human sin. But we all know how much damage any one person can do, because we have experienced it in our own sinful lives. One person can say and do things that hurt. Such things hurt another person, but they also hurt the very person who commits the offense. In addition, one person's offense may tarnish others—the family, the profession, or the church. One person can do a lot of damage.

At the beginning of Lent it is tempting to wallow in sin. This season will indeed turn our attention to our offenses. This is a perfect time of year to make a good examination of conscience and to bring our sin to the sacrament of reconciliation.

But there is more to Lent than sin. There is grace.

St. Paul told the Romans that death came into the world through one person's transgression, but "how much more will those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of justification come to reign in life through the one Jesus Christ."

One person can do a lot of good. The kindness we perform for another person can bring unexpected joy. And by the death and rising of Christ, sinners are made righteous.

Yes, reflect on sin this Lent, but remember also the grace. Jesus brings life to the world, and to you.




