TWELFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME


Dear Parish Family,

After overcoming the tiredness, drowsiness of a long flight, and the jet lag after flying through different time zones, I am glad to be back! Although I gratefully enjoyed my long awaited trip back home, I wish my two weeks away from you was all fun and relaxation...not quite so! The first few days were spent—believe it or not—in ministry! I guess you never stop being a priest! I was requested by the pastor of my home parish to preside and preach in the anniversary mass of the church consecration as a parish. Unfortunately, I had to say no to a cousin's request to officiate at his wedding since both celebrations happen to be on the same day. I have baptized 4 babies on different days. I have administered the last sacraments of a classmate who was stricken with cancer. I have celebrated mass everyday with my family and relatives and in the parish church where I grew up. I was able to visit the graves of my brother who passed away a few months ago and that of my sister in law. Because of COVID restrictions, I was not able to go home and attend their funerals. It was a great comfort on my part to finally be able to do that- which was one of the reasons to go back home. Another highlight of my visit was celebrating my 42nd anniversary in the priesthood in a mass together with priests that were ordained with me in 1981(five left). Though it was a very busy time with a lot of activities, and visiting relatives, old classmates in the seminary, and friends that I did not see for a long time, it certainly was a wonderful and enjoyable time! But there is also the expression of great joy and delight that I am back with my parish family!

I want to thank you for all the prayers you have offered for me! It was a great comfort to know you were lifting me up to the Lord in your prayers!






