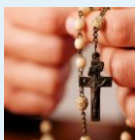
**In order to maintain the current schedule, We need adorers!** Please prayerfully consider spending one hour per week with Jesus - the Real Presence and source and summit of our faith.

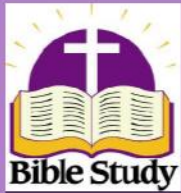

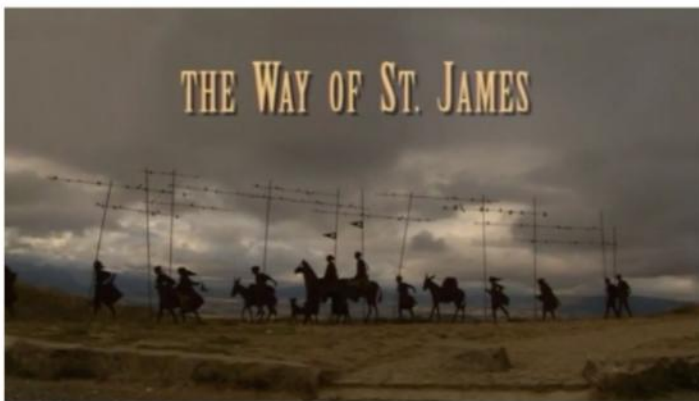
## Adult Faith Formation Presents...

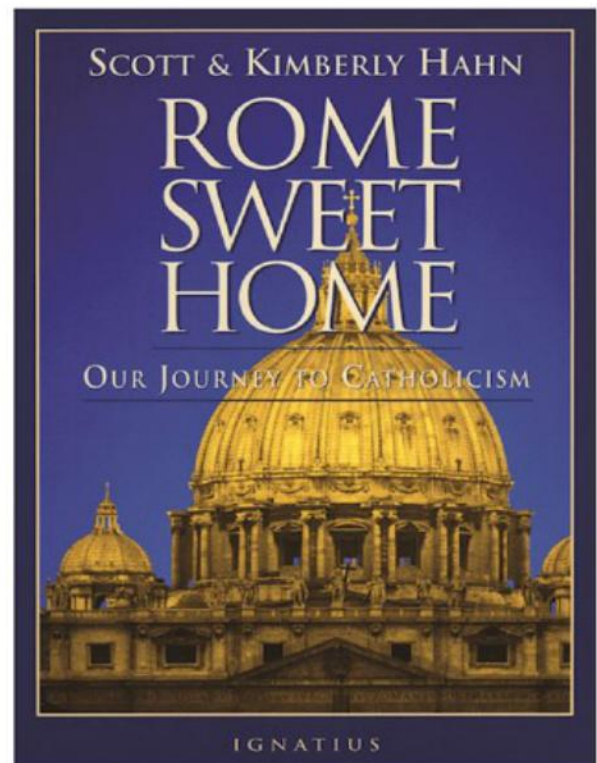
### The Way of Saint James

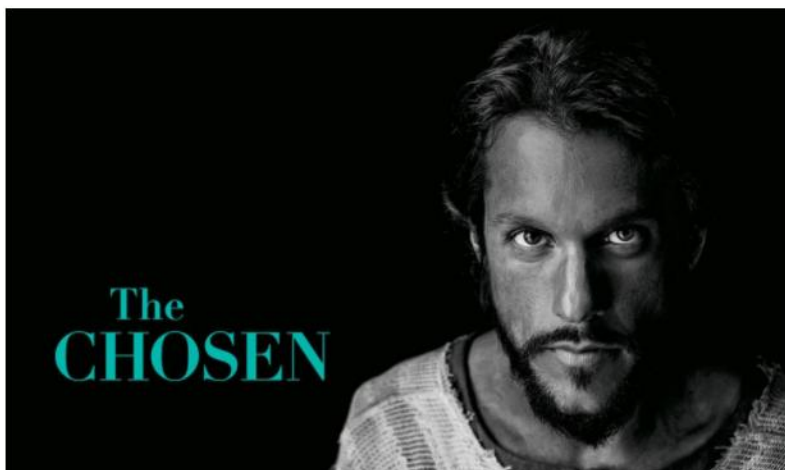
