Dear Parish Family,

It is with great excitement that I announce to you that we are moving forward with our plan to improve our church altar area, building a chapel, installing a baptismal font and other planned improvements. We have engaged Jackson and Ryan architects to evaluate and assess our facility needs. They have made the designs of the planned renovations which was approved by the archdiocese and our building committee. You can view the designs in the narthex of the church and in the family life center.

For you who are new to the parish, let me give you a little bit of history. More than 20 years ago, a plan was made to build a new church and a chapel for adoration. A capital campaign was started to raise the necessary funds for the planned church building. As the capital campaign was well on its way to raise the funds, it was temporarily stopped to give way to the Archdiocesan capital campaign to build a new Co-Cathedral of the Archdiocese. Our church was given a goal to achieve as well as all the other parishes. After achieving our goal to the Archdiocese, the momentum to continue our own capital campaign shifted due to the changing demographics and downturn of the economy. The need to build a new church was shelved and the funds raised were held with the Archdiocese for safe keeping.

And that brings us to the present. With the Cardinal's approval, we are going to use the funds for the much needed improvements for the church and fulfill at least its wish to build a chapel for adoration. At least a part of the plan will be accomplished.




