Dear Parish Family,

We are almost halfway through the season of Lent. On this 3rd Sunday of this holy season, we read about an incident in the life of Jesus in which He entered the temple and cleansed it of all that desecrated the holiness and sacredness of the place. All four Gospel writers spoke of this event, so it obviously held great significance in the first generation of the church. In St Mark's account, He cleansed the temple and forbade business there. In St Matthew's story, after He cleared the area, the sick came to Him and He cured them. St Luke indicates that Jesus drove out the sellers and then set up His teaching ministry there. In St John's, after the area was cleared, Jesus compared it to His body that will be destroyed and then raised up again. In each case, we see that Jesus claims the space for God and all that belongs to God. Jesus was always in "the business of His Father" and that occupied Him more than any other concern.

St Paul's 1st letter to the Corinthians 6,19 says, 'Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit?' It's telling us that we are God's dwelling places! How special that can be! Sad to say, sometimes we fill this God's temple with many unnecessary and unwanted clutters. Therefore it needs cleansing too. If we allow Jesus in, He too can cleanse us, as He did the Jerusalem temple, and make us truly a worthy dwelling place for God!

Thanks again to everyone who participated in the parish survey. Your input is greatly appreciated and is contributing to a two to three year parish plan.

As previously communicated a planning committee was formed in December to review and evaluate the results. This committee of nine includes Fr. Dwight, Aaron Ware, Traci Smith, Vicki Orscheln, Mike Futschik, Mark McBurnett, Dcn. Jeff Cadenhead, James Carrasco, & Dcn. John Kyle.

The committee has met with the Disciple Maker Survey consultant three times and three times independently of the consultant.

They have identified three improvement opportunity areas for the parish along with several goals for each opportunity.

The final meeting with the consultant in March will be to develop strategies and tasks which align with achieving the stated goals.

All of this will be drafted into a pastoral plan for the parish and communicated to everyone along with key take aways and findings from the survey.





Talking Points: Week 3 - Bread for the Journey

- The manna in the wilderness prefigures the Eucharist.
- The Eucharist sustains us on our spiritual journey and gives us a foretaste of Heaven.
- In the Mass, we worship with all the angels and saints in Heaven; in the Eucharist we are united to God and to everyone else who is in communion with him.
- The Liturgy of the Word includes readings from Scripture, the Responsorial Psalm, the homily, the Creed, and the Prayers of the Faithful.
- The Liturgy of the Eucharist makes present the sacrifice of Jesus on the Cross.
- We participate in the Mass by offering ourselves to God, united to the sacrifice of Christ.
- We must receive the Eucharist reverently and observe the Church's rules for doing so.
- The Mass sends us forth with a mission of love.




