Notes from Father Tom...

Archbishop (elect) Perez will be installed on Tuesday as the Archbishop of Philadelphia. He was here less than two and a half years but did a lot and is well respected by priests and the faithful. We wish him well. At the time writing this column, I do not know who the Apostolic Administrator will be but I imagine by the time you are reading this we will know. It could be a priest or a bishop from another diocese like we had the last time. I am speculating but not in print. There is no reason to worry. Rome has done this before.

It is time for the purple papers. For the last five or six years we have been writing what we plan to do for Lent on purple papers which are then placed on the back wall of the sanctuary in the form of two crosses. They form a visible reminder to us that together we do a lot during Lent both in support of those who will enter the Church at Easter and in personal spiritual growth. More about Lent next weekend but it is time now to decide what we are doing for Lent and to indicate that on a purple paper. If you can, return them next weekend so the crosses can be up for Lent.

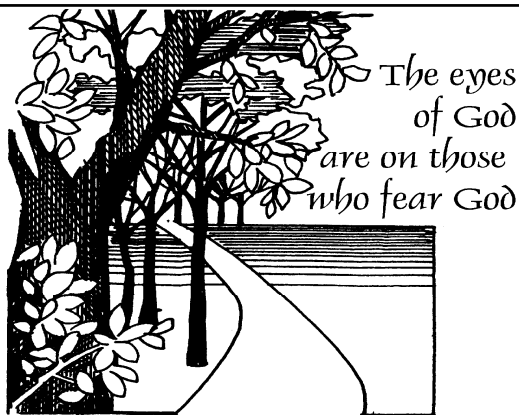

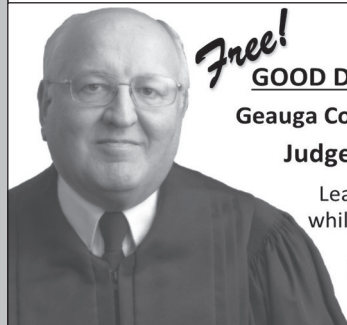
