

We are going to return the reception of Holy Communion to its correct place in the liturgy beginning this weekend. The staff and I have been talking about when to do this and the time is right. We tried to minimize people walking by each other. We also will modify the pattern for coming to Communion. We will use the center aisle and the two far side aisles for coming to Communion.

I hope you liked the Monday Night bit. Sister Denise Marie gave a marvelous talk on prayer. There is so much in the talk that it is worth watching over and over. Thanks to Michael Picha who is the announcer and camera man.

I am hearing confessions three times a week: Tuesday 7-8pm, Friday 10-10:30 am and Saturday 2-3pm. The confessional now is the old daily Mass chapel.

I went to Deacon Carl Varga's wake and funeral last week. Carl ministered at Divine Word for over 30 years. I got to know him when I was a student at St. Mary Seminary and he was taking classes in preparation for the diaconate. Then we were both assigned to St. Mary of the Assumption in Mentor. Carl was a true servant of the Church. May he rest in peace.



## SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

### Lenten Activities

**Weekend Mass**, either live streamed or in person is the top priority.

Each **Monday** at 7pm we will have Monday Night Live (live from Father Sweany's kitchen) which will feature Sister Denise Marie, Sister Noel, Deacon Cameron, Father Sweany and guests who, with a light hearted touch, will hopefully engage you in Lent. Presentations will be less than a half hour and will only be on-line.

Each **Wednesday** at 6pm we will have a Holy Hour including Benediction. Mass will follow at 7pm. Both are in person and live streamed.

Each **Friday** we will celebrate Stations of the Cross at 1:30 and 7pm. Both are in person in the church. We will live stream the 1:30pm Stations.

**Confessions:** Tuesday 7-8 pm, Friday 10:00-10:30am, and Saturday 2-3pm.

On **Good Friday**, April 2, a special presentation of **Stations of the Cross** by St. Anselm School Junior High students will be available for viewing all day.

**Children's Stations of the Cross** will be done on-line and archived so children can do them at any time during the week.

**Crosses:** Each family received a mailing, including two crosses. The crosses have little blocks, one for each day of Lent. You are encouraged to do two things for Lent, one sacrificial and one positive. For example, you might give up potato chips for Lent and you might say the rosary every day during Lent. On the day you do one or both, color in the block with pencil, pen or crayon.

### Fasting and Abstinence

**Abstinence** from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent by Roman Catholics 14 years of age and older.

**Fasting** is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by Roman Catholics 18-59 years of age. On these days, one full meal and two smaller meals are permitted.



**St. Casimir**

We live in a culture that tells children, "Follow your dreams! Be who you want to be!" It might be hard to imagine the courage it took to be St. Casimir. A prince second in line for the throne of Poland, the young man had great expectations placed upon him.



Inspired by a devout tutor, St. Casimir developed a deep faith. As a teenager, he would often sleep on the ground, reject courtly finery for plain clothes, and dedicate long hours to prayer. He even made a private commitment to celibacy. Casimir's avoidance of a military engagement made his father furious. The king imprisoned his own son. The episode confirmed to St. Casimir that he served a higher King, Jesus Christ. He would spend the rest of his life in prayer, study, and service to the poor. When we need courage to do what is right, St. Casimir, pray for us!



### When Sacrifice Becomes Mundane

It seems to happen every year, like clockwork: we drag a bit, as we enter into the second week of Lent. On Ash Wednesday, we feel a bit like soldiers banging our shields, rushing into battle. “We’re ready, God!” our hearts cry out. “Transform us through sacrifice! Your will be done!”

But by now, these Lenten resolutions are no longer novelties — they’ve joined the ranks of everyday inconveniences, which somehow are the hardest to bear. Because transformation, in real life, happens in inches, just as a battle is won slowly in the crash of one sword against another. It’s not always a dramatic thing, to the naked eye. It’s the perseverance in prayer despite weariness, or the continual denial of some pleasure even though there’s that nagging voice in our minds saying: *go ahead, God doesn’t really mind.*

It’s a week when we all need a shock to the system — and wouldn’t you know it, this Sunday God gives us a double-whammy of dramatic sacrificial scenes. We picture Abraham, who also cried “Ready!” when God called, never imagining what He would ask: the surrender of his long-awaited son. We see Christ himself transfigured, as God shows us what He is ready to give up for love of us.

We must remain committed, persevering daily in acknowledging that everything belongs to God. What we sacrifice, we simply give back to Him.

If God is for us, who can be against us? Can we still reply, “Ready!” when we hear the call of God?
