

Saint Spotlight of the Week:

St. Paschal Baylon

While the Church in much of Europe was struggling in the 1500s, there was a boon in the Iberian Peninsula. Many Saints of this time period came from Spain and Portugal. St. Paschal Baylon is one of those Saints. Paschal grew up in a poor and pious family. From the ages of 7-24, Paschal worked as a shepherd. He would often find himself praying while working, especially when he heard the Church bells. At 24, he would join the Franciscans as a brother. He was encouraged to enter the priesthood, but preferred the manual labor he could do as a religious brother. Like Francis of Assisi, Paschal observed the vow of poverty very carefully as he hated to waste anything, especially food. Some people would ask him for his council, to which he would encourage them to pray before the Blessed Sacrament (the Eucharist). Shortly after his death, people began to report miracles while visiting Paschal's tomb. He was canonized a Saint in 1690, and because of his great devotion to the Lord in the Eucharist, he was named the patron Saint of Eucharistic Congresses and societies in 1897. St. Paschal Baylon, Pray for us!






