

The wisdom of God is reflected in the face of the soul: she will see God as he is, and she will know as she is known. (St. Anthony of Padua)

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi! There's a special focus on what the Second Vatican Council called the "Source and Summit" of our Faith and the Sacramental life – The Eucharist. As we focus on being a bit more mindful of our identity as beloved Sons and Daughters of God, let's remind ourselves that at each Mass there's a miracle that happens right before our eyes. Simple unleavened bread and wine are transformed into the substance of the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ. While the accidental properties remain the same (the look and taste); at its very core, through the words of institution, they are transubstantiated into the Body and Blood of Christ. Truly a miracle that the God of the Universe loves us so much to nourish our body and soul in this way. When we come up to receive Communion, we respond with the word "Amen" meaning "yes, I believe".

Next weekend we say "farewell" to Sr. Denise Marie. If you'd like to say *thank you* to her for her $3\frac{1}{2}$ years of ministry at St. Anselm, consider coming to one of the Sunday Masses for a small social in Kelly Hall after both the 9am and 11am Masses. A special *thank you* goes out to the small committee of folks who are helping to organize the social.

While we may be saying "farewell" to Sr. Denise Marie soon, we say "welcome" to another member of our parish staff — Nicole Reichard. Nicole has been working very part time at St. Anselm since right around Advent. Her work can be seen on our parish website and social media. You might have also seen her take pictures at various events and Masses. She begins her full-time position at the parish as our Director of Communications and Evangelization. I look forward to seeing all the good work that she'll do at the parish. Be sure to introduce yourself when you see her.

This coming week on Tuesday we also open up the 2024 book for Mass intentions. Please note that there are still a few dates left in 2023 if you'd like to have a Mass offered for a loved one. While it's customary to often have Masses said for a deceased loved one, Masses are also able to be offered for the living. The Mass is our most powerful way to pray.





Saint Spotlight of the Week: St. Anthony of Padua

Anthony gave up a potential lucrative life of wealth and power to put on the brown habit of the Franciscans. Preparing to serve God in poverty, chastity, and obedience, Anthony would have his



life turned upside down as God would continue to call him to different ministries. Noted as an outstanding preacher, he would preach against several heresies during his lifetime. He would also instruct his fellow friars in theology. He always seemed to find the right words in various situations. Every day he would turn to God in prayer to help guide him in his leadership role. He would die at the age of 35 and would be canonized only one year after his death. He would be declared a Doctor of the Church in 1946 and his intercession is often sought to find lost things. St. Anthony, Pray for us!

Help Protect the Dignity of Life in Ohio

Life in its earliest and most vulnerable stages is threatened by groups proposing an amendment to the Ohio Constitution for the November 2023 ballot to expand and enshrine abortion at the expense of protections for preborn children and women. The Catechism of the Catholic Church proclaims that "human life must be



respected and protected absolutely from the moment of conception." The Church accompanies and supports women facing unexpected pregnancies and mothers through programs like Walking with Moms in Need and the services of Catholic Charities.

The bishops of Ohio strongly encourage Catholics statewide to unite in prayer and work to defeat this proposed amendment and its grave consequences for women and preborn children in Ohio. *Protect Them Both* materials about the proposed amendment are available in Ohio parishes:


