

Typically, in the month of July, things are a bit calmer at the parish, but there has been so much good to speak about. For starters, last week I highlighted the good news for those who wish to send their children to Catholic Schools. The State of Ohio budget now includes "Ed. Choice for All" which is a scholarship of approximately \$6,165 per student whose family income level is 450% or below the federal poverty level. For example, this would be a family of 4 whose adjusted gross income is at or below \$135k per year. And it is a sliding scale after that. So at the very least, each family who chooses to send their children to Catholic Schools will get at least \$615 per child towards their tuition. This is great news indeed! As always, feel free to reach out to Mrs. Therese Rose, our school principal, or myself for more information. You can call or email us with the contact information on the front of the bulletin. We hope to continue to have current information available on our website, social media, bulletin, and through parish email systems. Do realize that we do have limited space in each class for incoming students. St. Anselm School is an intentionally smaller school with a current K-8 student capacity of 25 students per class. This gives our families and faculty a chance to really get to know each other as well as receive the best education possible due to the smaller class sizes. Thank you to all of you for your support of our parochial school for over 60 years. It is a place where not only our students receive a stellar classroom education, but it is also where they encounter Christ daily.

Speaking of thanks, I am humbled by the great response to our summer BBQ raffle! I think we're getting closer to beating last year's number, and I think we would all love to see that. Thank you so much for sending in those tickets. It's hard to believe that the BBQ is only two weeks from this weekend. This weekend's bulletin has a schedule of the events planned for the day, beginning with outdoor Mass at 11am. Along the counter outside of the Daily Mass Chapel are sign-up sheets to help volunteer for the event. Please consider signing up your family to help with our myriad of activities.

#### Saint Spotlight of the Week: St. Lawrence of Brindisi

If all of us were to look back through our lives, we could recall the names of the very intelligent people whom we've encountered. When it comes to Church history, one of those very intelligent people is Lawrence of Brindisi. He



was a master linguist who fluently spoke and wrote 7 languages. He was so good at each of these languages, that the natives often thought he was one of them. When he would preach to the Jewish people in Rome, because of his mastery of the Hebrew language, they thought he was a Jewish convert to Christianity. Sometimes with great intelligence can come a difficulty with empathy. This was not the case for Lawrence. He was noted for his deep care for people as a Capuchin Franciscan. He was elected the minister general of the order, and was responsible for its rapid growth in the year 1602. In addition to this role, the Holy Father appointed him as the Papal Emissary and peacemaker, a position that would take him around the world wherein he could employ his ability with languages, his grasp of theology, while remaining compassionate to everyone he met. He was well-written, and the Franciscans have catalogued a 15-volume edition of his writings. St. Lawrence of Brindisi, Pray for us!


