

Saint Spotlight of the Week:**St. John Vianney**

When Catholics befriend a Saint or choose a favorite Saint, we often select one (or several) based on their life story and/or of what he/she may be the patron Saint. In the case of St. John Vianney, all Catholic priests have a devotion to him because he is the patron Saint of the priesthood. Born and raised in France, John would eventually be ordained a priest. He



would be sent to Ars France to serve the people in an area that didn't have much of a thriving population. The people of Ars were quite apathetic/indifferent to faith. But after encountering this holy priest at Mass and Reconciliation, people came from all over Europe to meet whom they would eventually call the "Cure of Ars". It wasn't odd to see Fr. Vianney in the confessional for 11-16 hours per day. It was said that even the devil would interrupt his sleep so that John would be too weary to be in the confessional, but he always found a way to make it. Say a prayer through the intercession of St. John Vianney this week for all parish priests. St. John Vianney, pray for us!

Wonder what we are up to in the Religious Education/Formation Office? Well, presently I am finishing interviewing our children/parents of our Homeschool PSR Program. This is a way of knowing what both parents and children learned together.



We are beginning to prepare the necessary materials for our catechists and aides in PSR. We do this not even knowing who all of the PSR staff will be. Now that is living in faith AND hope!


