



He would be sent to Ars

France to serve the people in an area that didn't have much of a thriving population. The people of Ars were quite apathetic/indifferent to faith. But after encountering this holy priest at Mass and Reconciliation, people came from all over Europe to meet whom they would eventually call the "Cure of Ars". It wasn't odd to see Fr. Vianney in the confessional for 11-16 hours per day. It was said that even the devil would interrupt his sleep so that John would be too weary to be in the confessional, but he always found a way to make it. 
Our next step is sending out information to all the families with 8<sup>th</sup> graders letting them know that we will have our first Confirmation meeting later in August.
