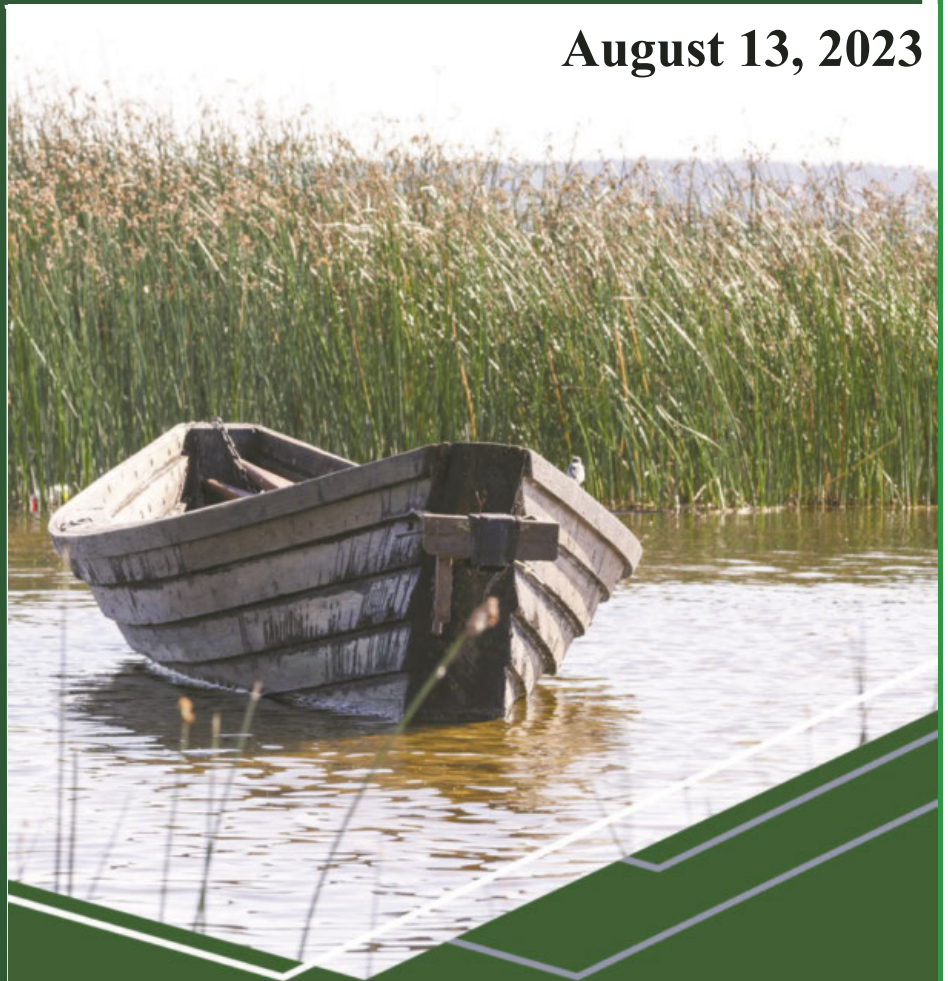

Last year, we hosted a missionary priest from the Augustinian Fathers who served at various points on the African Continent. Next weekend we're happy to host Fr. Stephen Mutie, S.A.C of the Irish Pallottine Fathers. Fr. Stephen will speak about his Order's missionary work in Tanzania, Colombia, and Kenya. Currently, Fr. Stephen serves at a parish in Michigan. There will be a second collection during the offertory next weekend to help support the evangelization and development work of the Irish Pallottines in these struggling countries.

On Tuesday, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption, a Holy Day of Obligation. As always, opportunities for Masses and prayer can be found in our weekly bulletin, website, and social media.

This week our dedicated faculty of St. Anselm School arrive back in their classrooms to begin preparing for the year. Please consider praying for them and their students this week. As Deacon Bob told us in his homily last week, change can be hard sometimes, but we place our trust that God will take good care of His people. Transitioning from summer break to school is an experience we all have had. Let's pray for those making that transition soon.

I mentioned at the Masses last weekend that we had a flood in our Baptismal font recently that affected the entire Baptistry. I'm very grateful to the quick response from our parish staff to get us in touch with the right people to get the problem remedied in a very timely fashion. The problem could have been a lot worse, but we got through it well. In fact, because it was all Holy Water, it could be the "holiest vestibule" in the Diocese.

Encounter Church

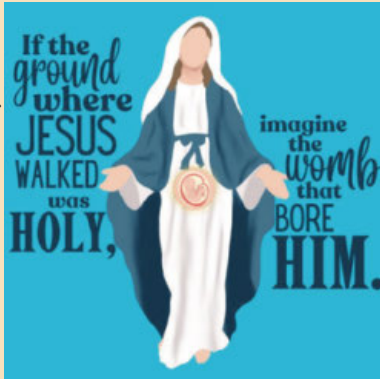
Mary, Mother of God

One of the most common objections to the Catholic Church is the misconception that Catholics “worship” Mary. While we do pay Mary a special kind of respect and reverence, this reverence should not be mistaken for the worship that we give to God.

We recognize that God alone deserves worship. God alone is the one to whom we give total adoration. This is a term known as *latria*. Since God alone is Holy, and divine, we love and serve and worship Him in a way not given to any other being.

There is another type of reverence or respect that is given to the saints, those who have practiced lives of heroic virtue in love and dedication to God and neighbor. This type of reverence is known as *dulia*. All of the saints lived holy lives, some died rather than renouncing their faith, and some, like Saint Therese of Lisieux, lived holiness in a “little way.” Regardless of what each saint’s path to holiness looked like, we reverence their achievements with *dulia*.

Mary, the Mother of God, is in a category all her own. The special type of reverence that we pay to Mary is called *hyperdulia*. As she is without sin, and bore Christ to the world, Mary is the Theotokos, or “God-bearer.” Her sinlessness and complete surrender to the Father’s will set her apart from the other saints. Since Mary was without sin, she did not have to bear the price of sin, which is death. This is why we will celebrate the Feast of the Assumption on August 15.

Notes from Sister Noel

It is amazing where and how we receive the significant messages which we may act on and many times it may become a touch stone in approaching a facet of our faith and/or our life.



Very early in my teaching experience, one of my brothers gave me this nugget of wisdom that I have carried throughout my teaching career. He was really sharing his own experience as a student. He told me that in the classroom I may be interacting well with the more verbal students and may be missing the quiet ones. Pay attention to each of them.

Some need to be coaxed out. They have something to say but need to be seen first. Wow! That was a gift to me to give to others.

In our Scripture this weekend, when Elijah was told to watch for God’s passing by, Elijah had his own idea of how God would come. God surprised Elijah by coming in a way less demonstrative than the heavy wind or earthquake (though those were also possibilities). God came in a tiny whispering sound.

Get the message? God comes in a myriad of ways. God is calling us to use our eyes and ears! How has God broken through to you in both the stunning events and the quiet whispers in your life? What did you do about what you heard? Did it set a new direction? Change a relationship? Slow you down in a good way? Or enliven us to get engaged in something new?

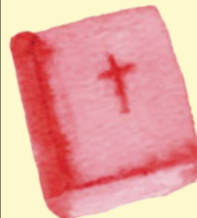
God is calling us. To what or who is God now calling you to encounter? It may even be to look for God in a more intentional way. Pray about it.

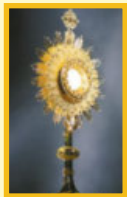
