PAPAL PRIMACY

A common objection of non-Catholics to the Catholic faith is the office of pope. There are often misunderstandings of what the pope's role is within the Church, or the Scriptural foundations of the papacy.

As Catholics, we believe that Divine Revelation comes to us from Sacred Scripture *as well as* Sacred Tradition—both of which point to the existence of the papacy. We know that Christ established the Church while He was on earth. He then entrusted the Church to the Apostles under the watchful care of the Holy Spirit to guide His people to Heaven. It is for these reasons that the Church, the Mystical Body of Christ, is not simply a human institution, but a divine one as well. Unlike the Apostles, the Church was made to last for all ages. Therefore, Christ began a hierarchy, even within His intimate group of friends (the Apostles). Christ intended that the Church would support and guard integrity of the Revelation that He left behind. He wanted to ensure that the whole truth of His teaching would remain intact.

In Matthew's Gospel, after Peter's profession of faith in Jesus as the Christ, Jesus give Peter a new name, and thus also a new role. Peter was to start his life anew as the rock on which Jesus would build His Church. After Jesus' Resurrection, He gives Peter the task of, "feed my sheep...tend my lambs." Peter is to follow in the footsteps of Christ as shepherd of His people.

Of course, whoever is in the role of pope does not act alone. He acts always in communion with the College of Bishops, with the guidance of the Holy Spirit, especially when discerning certain matters of faith and morals. The pope is called always to act as Christ did, in laying down his life for the Church, in caring for the Church through teachings, and through humble example.

Notice something different at Mass? The Saint Anselm music ministry is excited to begin singing new Ordinaries (Gloria, Holy, Holy, Lamb of God, etc.), beginning the first weekend of September. The Gloria is from the Belmont Mass by Christopher Walker, and can be found at the back of the hymnal, #848. The Holy, Holy is found on p. 14 at the beginning of the hymnal in the Order of Mass. The Memorial Acclamation (A), Amen, and Lamb of God are found in this same Order of Mass on pgs. 16, 26, and 27. We hope these new musical settings offer a refreshing way to contemplate the texts of these important prayers we pray at every Mass. And don't worry if you miss the Mass of Creation setting we've been using for the past two years—we will still use this version during Christmas and Easter time. It may take a few weeks to become familiar with the new music, and that is normal! We will have "practice preludes" for the next couple weekends during the 10 minutes before each Mass for anyone who wishes to join.




