The Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit

Typically, the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit are most often discussed in the context of the Sacrament of Confirmation, but not much farther beyond that. Yet, these gifts are a vast treasury of graces freely given to us from God to help us in our journey to Him.

What are the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit? They are heroic character traits that Jesus Christ alone possesses in their fullness but that He freely shares with the members of His mystical body (the Church). Every Christian receives all Seven Gifts of the Spirit at the moment he or she is baptized. The Gifts of the Spirit are nurtured in us when we practice virtuous living, and they are sealed and matured in us in the Sacrament of Confirmation. They are also known as the Sanctifying Gifts of the Spirit, because they serve the purpose of making us open to the movements of the Holy Spirit in our lives, helping us grow in holiness and making us fit for Heaven.

According to Saint Thomas Aquinas, these gifts are “habits,” “instincts,” or “dispositions” provided by God as supernatural helps to us in the process of our perfection. These Gifts of the Holy Spirit allow us to rise above the limits of our wounded nature so that we can participate in the very life of God Himself, just as Christ promised. Aquinas also said that the Gifts of the Spirit are necessary for our salvation, which we cannot achieve on our own.

Let’s take a quick look at what each of the Seven Gifts are:

1. **Wisdom**: is the ability to exercise good judgment. It distinguishes between right and wrong, seeks and upholds truth and justices, and balances personal good with common good. Wisdom demonstrates common sense and prudence.
2. **Understanding**: the gift of intelligence and enlightenment. It is the ability to think clearly; to perceive, comprehend and interpret information, and to have insight and discern meaning.
3. **Counsel**: is good advice. It is the ability to teach, inform, guide, direct, warn, admonish, recommend and encourage. It is not limited to the giving of advice, but extends to the ability to graciously receive it.
4. **Fortitude**: is an unwavering commitment to God or a proper course of action and it shows itself as moral strength, courage, determination, patient endurance, a resolute spirit, stamina, and resiliency.
5. **Knowledge**: is the ability to study and learn; to acquire, retain, and master facts and information; and to put what is learned to good use for constructive purposes.
6. **Piety**: is personal holiness, and it includes devotion to God, prayer, virtue, goodness, decency, self-mastery, innocence, the avoidance of sin and obedience to God’s will.
7. **Fear of the Lord**: also known as Wonder and Awe, is reverence and respect for God. It acknowledges that everything comes from God, downplays personal achievement and self-sufficiency, and gladly offers praise, worship, and adoration to God.

It is no secret that living the Christian life can be difficult at times. If we truly follow after Christ in carrying our crosses, there will be times of suffering and difficulty. Yet the Gifts of the Holy Spirit bring us a beautiful hope; they assure us that God has not left us alone on our way to Heaven. They give us the tools that we need to arm ourselves against whatever snares the evil one will throw our way, our spiritual weaponry for the spiritual warfare of everyday life. Most importantly, the Gifts of the Spirit are the very life of God dwelling within us. We receive this life at the moment of our Baptism. Confirmation completes this grace since we receive a “special strength of the Holy Spirit.” Next time you’re facing a difficult situation, take a step back and remember that you have the Holy Spirit’s very life within you, and be not afraid!

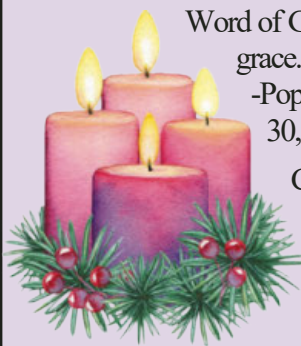


Advent Praying with Scripture
