# Encounter Church

### Praying for Sports Teams?

Most of us have experienced or are at least familiar with the feeling of being invested in the outcome of a sports game. Whether it's a professional team or perhaps that of a family member, there's an intense feeling as we await the results of a game or match. Sometimes we might even pray for a certain outcome. But what is the purpose of this? And doesn't God see these things as trivial?

The truth is this: when put in the proper perspective, sports and leisure are a great source of fun and relaxation. And our participation in sports and other such activities are beneficial to our physical and mental health. God is happy when we have the ability to relax in these good ways (again, provided we are prioritizing such activities responsibly). These things can even have a positive impact on our spiritual life. They can teach us different ways of thinking and praying.

For example: we know that God doesn't choose sides for a sports team. Every person that He has created is good and precious to Him, and He only wants good things for His children. However, if we do find ourselves wanting to bring sports into our prayer (like maybe for a big upcoming football game), we can do so in a way that benefits everyone, players and spectators alike.

We start by thanking God for the gifts of our bodies: for the players who have been blessed with health and ability to play the game, for us and our families, who have the opportunity to take in and enjoy the sport as a recreational activity. We then ask God to protect and be with the players, coaches, officials, and spectators: that each would be kept safe from harm and injury. We ask that both teams are given the presence of mind to be fair, and practice good sportsmanship. Finally, we ask God to send His Spirit of Wisdom among all those involved in the sporting event, so that good choices can be made, and personal growth can be achieved by all players, according to God's plan for them.

All in all, inviting God into the simple things such as sporting events can help us to sanctify our every day lives, even if it is "just a game."

### Notes from Sister Noel

February is the shortest month of the year. This year we celebrate Valentine's Day and Ash Wednesday on the same day, Wednesday, February 14. Yes, there are some challenges to face.

The Church calls us to begin Lent with a day of fasting. Valentine's Day often means parties, sweet treats

and valentine cards from our friends and/or family. What a combination! How do we bring what seems so different to be compatible?

How about eating our sweet treats on Tuesday? We can still do the loving acts of care and service. We could write caring notes each day and then surprise someone with it. It is good. It calls for us to find what is at the "heart" of both. Both days are about giving of ourselves to others.

Let me give you an idea or two. We could spend quality time with someone who looks, or sharing clothes or things we do not use anymore. There are many collection stations in Chesterland for donations.

Adding Valentine's Day to the official beginning of Lent allows us to see whatever we sacrifice whether it is time, treasure or talent are expressions of love for God and our neighbor.

Maybe emailing or sending a card to someone lets them know they are remembered. Praying for them could be one of our practices. Is it possible to pray a rosary daily for peace? Come to a weekday Mass or Stations of the Cross.

Could we practice softening our tone or conversing with someone who thinks differently than you? Do we need to practice listening with curiosity and not judgement?

Let's prepare for Lenten. Call upon the Spirit to help you know what you need to do or need to stop doing. Let's pray for each other as we begin.


