From the Desk of Fr. Chris

"Be merciful, O Lord, for we have sinned." (Ash Wednesday Psalm Response)

This weekend there is much to celebrate. We not only had our Catholic Charities Annual Appeal, but it's also World Marriage Sunday: an opportunity to not only recognize the vocation of marriage, but to pray for those who are married.

We're in the last few days before the Church around the world begins the Season of Lent this Wednesday (Ash Wednesday). As promised, you'll find a variety of resources to help you and your family have a very grace-filled Lent. This weekend you can find Lenten daily-reflection books as well as a few handouts from our friends at *Hallow*. Some of us find great value in physical resources, while others enjoy using their smart devices as a Lenten companion. You may have seen advertisements for *Hallow* before on Social Media, TV ads, or even if you receive Catholic periodicals. Nicole, our Director of Communications and Evangelization, created a small flyer with what free programming is available on *Hallow* (there is a small monthly subscription fee for some of the content).

Consider joining us for the Stations of the Cross each Friday during Lent either at 1:15pm or 7pm in the Church led by various members of the parish staff. Beginning on Friday February 23rd through the remainder of Lent, students from our St. Anselm School Community will lead us in praying the Stations of the Cross. Brandan Bizzi, our Director of Youth and Young Adult Ministries, is now meeting with our junior high parishioners to work on Living Stations of the Cross.

Last year, Deacon Bob and I highlighted the 7 Deadly Sins and the 7 Lively Virtues in our Lenten homilies. As a way to help our parish enter more deeply into the national Eucharistic Revival and our annual parish theme, "Encounter Christ", Deacon Bob and I will once again focus our Lenten homilies on a specific theme. This year we will be diving deeper into the parts of the Mass so that each of us has a deeper appreciation for what we call *the greatest form of prayer*. I look forward to walking through the Mass each week with you, highlighting different parts each week.

May God bless each of us abundantly this Lenten Season. May we all grow in our relationship with God and learn to slow down just a bit more.
