

### From the Desk of Fr. Chris

"The woman said to him, 'I know that the Messiah is coming, the one called the Christ; when he comes, he will tell us everything.' Jesus said to her, 'I am he, the one who is speaking with you'." (John 4: 25-26)



The 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Lent is a marker for many things in our parish. The Catholic Church around the world celebrates the first of 3 Scrutinies, which call members of the RCIA to further conversion and purification as they approach the Easter Vigil. It marks a moment for each of us to continue the progress we've made so far in Lent. They say that a "new habit" is formed in 21 days. One of the days in the week ahead of us marks the 21st day of Lent. It's a time to continue that good momentum as we come closer and closer to Easter. This 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Lent is a time for us at St. Anselm as we reflect further upon the Mass – this week we focus more on the part of the Mass called "the Liturgy of the Eucharist". Rebecca, our bulletin editor, has once again recapped last week's homily on the "Liturgy of the Word" in the Encounter Church column of this bulletin.

You may have noticed that there's been a flurry of recent activities at the parish. You may have driven by the parish on Chillicothe Road or perhaps you've attended one of these many events. Thank you to so many of our volunteers, families, and staff members who have helped to keep this parish active each day from sunrise to sunset. I am proud of our growing and active community. Thank you for your support of our programs and for your financial support which helps support many of these events, programs, and the structural integrity of our buildings.

# Encounter Church

### fent Week 2: Liturgy of the Word

This week in our Masses we were blessed to hear from Deacon Bob as he spoke to us about the Liturgy of the Word. Deacon Bob began by comparing the Ambo to the Altar. The *ambo* is the term for the small table where the Scriptures are proclaimed at every Mass. Both of these tables feed and nourish us in different ways.

The First and Second Reading: The Liturgy of the Word begins with the first reading that often relates directly to the Gospel. At the beginning of these readings, we respond to the proclamation with the words "thanks be to God." In doing this, we are telling God that we are grateful to be in His presence and hear His saving words. The second reading helps us to know and understand our faith more deeply, and to strengthen us.

**The Responsorial Psalm**: The beautifully written Psalms offer us a chance to quite literally *respond* to God's saving words in the full range of human emotion. There is a psalm for every occasion!

The Gospel: Gospel is a word that means "Good News." We show special reverence for the Gospel as we stand to listen to the good news of Jesus' saving actions. The priest or deacon will often elevate the Book of the Gospels to show that the words in this book are very special. Like all of the Scriptures, the words of the Gospel are those of God Himself, though put onto paper by human writers.

**Homily**: Comes from the Greek word for explanation. Clergy who give the Homily will spend time praying over the words of Scripture to share the knowledge of the message that God wants to be shared with His people

**Creed**: Our creed is a statement of the things we believe. We repeat these words weekly to remind us of what we believe. Deacon Bob compared the statements "2+2=4" with "I love you." Both of these statements may express truth, but they are very different. One affects relationship different than another. By stating our beliefs, we are further strengthened in our relationship with God.

**Petitions**: Similar to the collect at the beginning of the Mass, the petitions allow us to bring the needs of one another to the feet of Christ.

The Altar is the table of the Eucharist, but the Ambo is the table of the Word. Both of these tables give us all we need to be sustained as we are sent forth to serve the world. The Word reminds us where God is in our daily lives, in our hearts.

### Notes from Sister Noel

Sr. Maureen and I just completed a beautiful 550 piece puzzle that we had gradually worked on together after the holidays. It was a joy to place our last pieces into their places. Yet joy was not the only experience in doing the puzzle!



There was something very familiar with trying to get the "picture" when we could only see a part. There were times I really doubted that all the pieces were really there! I only continued to believe they were there because we had opened the sealed bag thus knowing we were the first to work on it. Certainly, the intelligence and experience of the designers knew how to pack it right!

Doesn't that sound like our attempting to figure out life? We are so happy when we get it right, even though we may have doubted along the way. The important thing is we did not give up. We just kept going, trusting we would find the answer in good time.

We who have faith rely on the Holy Spirit to continue directing us. It does take us a while to get the "big picture" and to find where we belong in it.

In working the puzzle, we may get frustrated and start jamming our piece in so it would fit. We then look at the picture and we notice the colors don't really match and so with a little or (a lot) of impatience we take it out and admit, there is a piece but this one is not it.

I did like the moments that a piece just slipped in without any effort. I would just stare at what just happened! Things were coming together! Are we not amazed when something that stymies us suddenly works? In those moments, I'd often say, "that's God at work". Or should I say, God is at play? God loves puzzles and the puzzlers!

God waits for us. God has been with us throughout our doubts, setbacks, jamming, joys etc. Lent is a time that provides moments for us to continue searching for God and asking God how do we fit into His "big picture"? In God's good time we will come to know the answer. Be patient with yourself as God is with us.
