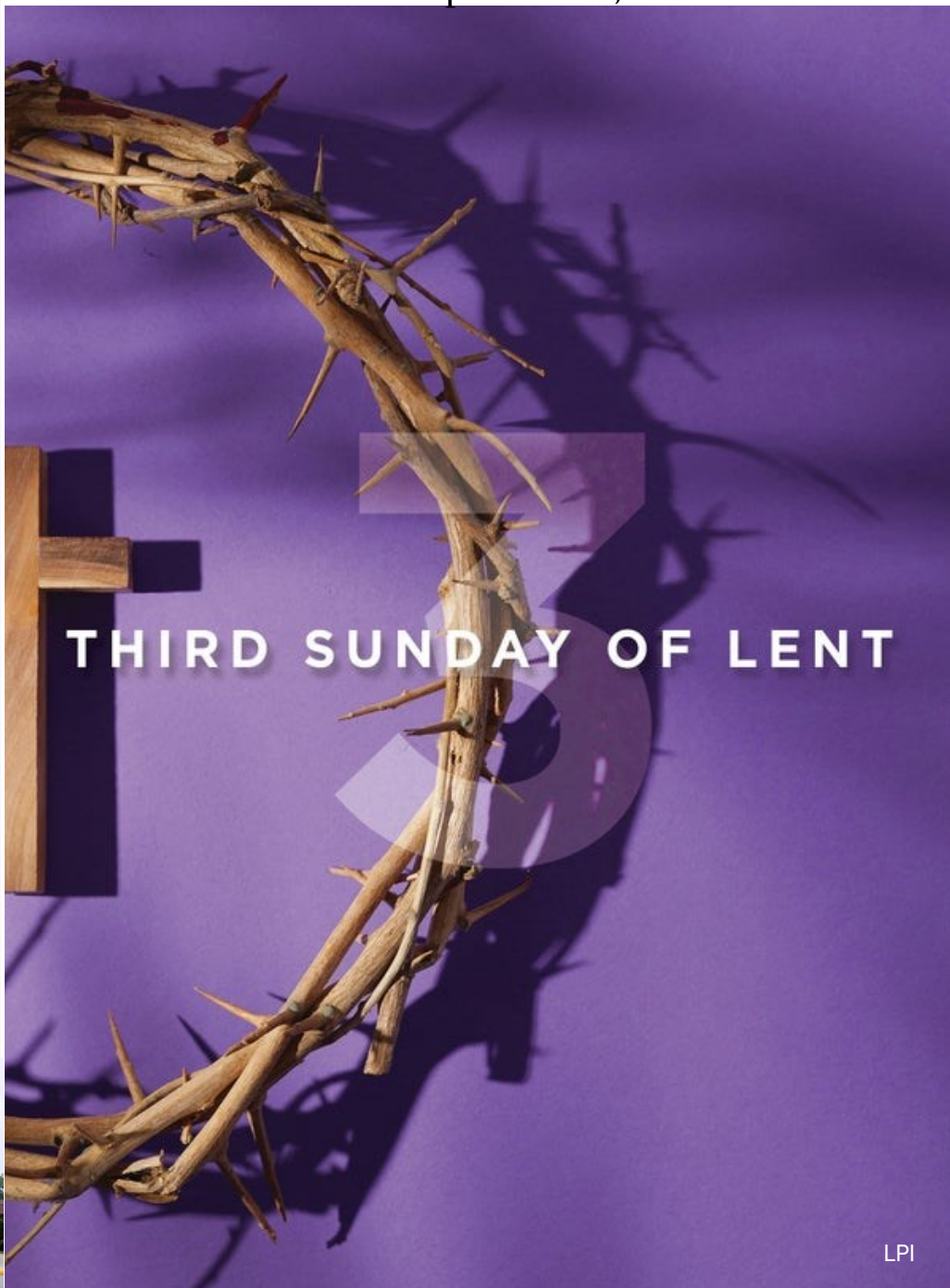

## Lenten Regulations

Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence. The precept of Fast means that, on that day, only one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, just sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, except for liquids. The Law of Fast applies to those between the ages of 18 and 60, but is encouraged for all Catholics.

The precept of Abstinence prohibits the eating of any meat on those designated days, and applies to those who are 14 years of age or older, although it is recommended for all Catholics.

Catholics are also earnestly urged to receive the Sacrament of Penance during the Lenten season, preferably before Holy Thursday.

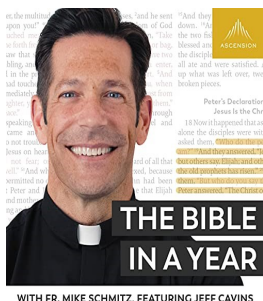

The text program with Flocknote limits the number of characters allowed in each text.
