
It's Not Too Late to Sign Up Your Children for Religious Education Classes

Religious Education classes will be held on Sundays from 10:40 am - 11:45 am.

Attendance Requirement for First Communion and Confirmation Students:

All youth planning on their First Communion and Confirmation are required to attend Religious Education classes for two years before receiving their Sacrament and are to miss no more than five (5) Masses or five (5) religious education classes in the school year.

Students preparing for their First Communion or Confirmation should attend Sunday Mass and Religious Education classes every week. There is an attendance sheet in the Sacristy, the door to the right of the Tabernacle at the front of Church, to track your attendance at Mass. Following Mass, the Confirmation students and a parent of the First Communion students are to personally sign the attendance sheet.
