Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today we celebrate Palm Sunday which marks the beginning of Holy Week. Holy week is filled with many rich celebrations. I encourage you attend as many as you can. If it is a matter of choosing between one or another, I suggest choosing one that you have never attended (or one it has been a long time since you have attended).

Above all, however, I encourage you to attend the Good Friday Liturgy. The Good Friday Liturgy is called the Celebration of the Passion of the Lord. This service consists of a reading of the Passion, (like we did today though from the Gospel of John instead of Luke), veneration of the Cross (in which everyone comes forward to touch or kiss the cross) and reception of Holy Communion.

I hope to see you at some of the celebrations this week.

Our Pastorate is in the process of applying for automated external defibrillators (AED's) for our 3 parish sites.

The Revive and Survive AED program, a partnership between Franciscan Health and North Central Health Services, is providing the AED's. Part of the requirements for placement is having 5 members per AED from each parish trained in CPR and AED use. (American Heart Association or American Red Cross certifications only). If possible there will be 1 device at St. Joseph's, Reynolds; 2 devices at OLOL and at St. Joseph's, Delphi. If you wish to volunteer for this, please contact Ann Minnicus (765-714-8524) for St. Joseph, Delphi and Barb Mathew or Terrie Brown at the parish office in Monticello for OLOL and St. Joseph, Reynolds. If you need CPR and AED certifications, free classes are available or will be covered by each parish if there is a cost. Thank you for considering this Important ministry for our Pastorate.

Rejoice in God's Mercy

Every family needs God's mercy. Every family should know about the Feast of Mercy. Lenten prayers, fasts, alms giving and good deeds afford us the opportunity to prepare well for the reception of Divine Mercy showered upon the world in an extraordinary way the Second Sunday of Easter each year. Turn to the Lord with trust for all of your needs, spiritual as well as temporal. Ask for much and join the hundreds of thousands that have received hope, healing and answers to many prayers on this special day. Rejoice in the Resurrection. Rejoice in God's Mercy.

"The more a soul trusts, the more it will receive."

(Jesus to St. Faustina, *Diary*, 1578)

During Mercy Sunday celebrations in Vilnius, Poland in 1935 St. Faustina recorded:

When he [Blessed Fr. Michael Sopocko] began to speak about the great mercy of the Lord, the image [Divine Mercy] came alive and the rays pierced the hearts of the people gathered there, but not all to the same degree. Some received more, some less. (417)

"No soul that has called upon My mercy has ever been disappointed."

The Feast of Mercy



When Jesus revealed the sacred image of Himself as The Divine Mercy to Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska on February 22, 1931, He declared: "I desire that there be a Feast of Mercy. I want this image, which you will paint with a brush, to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter; that Sunday is to be the Feast of Mercy." (*Diary*, 49)



A DAY OF EXTRAORDINARY GRACE

Jesus repeatedly asked that this ancient, forgotten feast be officially proclaimed by the Church. Christ promised that on this day His Mercy would be overflowing to those who would ask for it. Jesus told St. Faustina:

"My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy." (699)

On the Feast of Mercy, Sunday, April 30, 2000, Saint Pope John Paul II fulfilled the Lord's request when he decreed, "The Second Sunday of Easter from now on throughout the Church will be known as 'Divine Mercy Sunday.'"

THE PROMISES OF THE FEAST OF MERCY

"The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet." (699)

"Ordinarily, only the sacrament of Baptism effects in the soul the 'complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.' Reception of the Eucharist in a state of grace ordinarily remits only venial sin, while strengthening the soul against both venial and mortal sin (Catechism, 1394-1395). But on Mercy Sunday reception of Holy Communion worthily and with trust in God's Mercy pours out upon the soul a complete renewal of baptismal grace." - Rev. Ignacy Rozycki, STD, Former Member of the Holy See's International Theological Commission.

If you or someone you know has been a victim of past or current child sexual abuse by clergy (priest or deacon), you are asked to report the incident as follows:

1. Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556 or local police.
2. Call Jackie Montrie M.A., LMFT, LMHC Victim Assistance Coordinator for the Diocese of Lafayette-en-Indiana at (765) 464-4988.
3. Thereafter, an investigation will be conducted by, or on behalf of, the Diocese of Lafayette-en-Indiana.

If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse in the past or currently by someone who works in a parish or school for the Catholic Church in the Diocese of Lafayette-en-Indiana (such as a religious brother or sister, lay employee, lay volunteer, etc.) you are asked to report the incident as follows:

4. Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556 or local police.

If you ever get such a request, it is NOT from Fr. Dan or Fr. Chris. He will NEVER ask for your financial help in an email or text message. If you get such a message, do not open the link. Simply delete it.
