

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK/DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PASTOR

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Since we celebrate the Fourth of July this Friday, it is good time to remember that many of the early colonists came here seeking religious freedom. Since the Church of England was the state religion it was common for other faiths to face opposition, persecution or even violence.

The same Protestant groups who fled England in pursuit of toleration and religious liberty brought with them, however, an utter hatred for the Catholic Church. They installed laws and customs that excluded Catholics from all aspects of public life.

Maryland was intended to be a place where Catholics were welcomed and permitted to share in the dream of a new life which brought so many others to America. But Maryland was not exclusively for Catholics. George Calvert who founded the colony of Maryland was a realist, and he knew that the long-term chances of the colony were better if it observed genuine religious liberty.

What happened to the Catholics in the colonial days, who pursued their dream, is a reminder that the freedoms we take for granted today were hardwon by those who came before us.

Happy Fourth, In Christ, Fr. Dan Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo,

Dado que celebramos el Cuatro de Julio este viernes, es un buen momento para recordar que muchos de los primeros colonos vinieron aquí en busca de libertad religiosa. Dado que la Iglesia de Inglaterra era la religión del estado, era común que otras fe enfrentaran oposición, persecución o incluso violencia.

Los mismos grupos protestantes que huyeron de Inglaterra en busca de tolerancia y libertad religiosa trajeron consigo, sin embargo, un odio absoluto hacia la Iglesia Católica. Instalaron leyes y costumbres que excluían a los católicos de todos los aspectos de la vida pública.

Maryland fue concebido como un lugar donde los católicos eran bienvenidos y se les permitía compartir el sueño de una nueva vida que trajo a tantos otros a América. Pero Maryland no era exclusivamente para católicos. George Calvert, quien fundó la colonia de Maryland, era un realista, y sabía que las posibilidades a largo plazo de la colonia eran mejores si observaba una verdadera libertad religiosa.

Lo que sucedió con los católicos en los días coloniales, quienes persiguieron su sueño, es un recordatorio de que las libertades que damos por sentadas hoy fueron ganadas con esfuerzo por aquellos que vinieron antes que nosotros.


