FROM THE PASTOR’S DESK/DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PASTOR

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today I will share with you a short biography of St. Junipero Serra. Junipero was canonized in September when the Pope was here in the US. He was the first Saint canonized on US soil.

St. Junipero Serra was born in 1713 in Spain to Antonio Nadal Serra and Margarita Rosa Ferrer and given the name Miguel José. At age 16 he entered the Franciscan Order. He assisted teaching philosophy before his ordination to the priesthood and later received the degree of Doctor of Theology.

At his own request he was assigned to a Mission in Mexico. He served there for nine years, learned the language of the Pame Indians, and translated the catechism into their language. He became famous as a most fervent and effective preacher of missions. In 1767 he was appointed superior of a band of fifteen Franciscans for the Missions of Lower California. In 1769 he accompanied an expedition to Upper California.

He founded the first of the twenty-one California missions which accomplished the conversions of the natives on the coast. Those established by Father Serra or during his administration were San Carlos; San Antonio; San Gabriel; San Luis Obispo; San Francisco de Asís; San Juan Capistrano; Santa Clara; San Buenaventura. He was also present at the founding of Santa Barbara.

In 1778 he received the faculty to administer the Sacrament of Confirmation. He once more visited the missions from San Diego to San Francisco, six hundred miles, in order to confirm all who had been baptized. He suffered intensely from a crippled leg and from his chest, yet he would use no remedies. He confirmed 5309 persons. His virtues were fortitude, zeal, love of mortification, self-denial, and absolute confidence in God.

In 1884 the Legislature of California passed a concurrent resolution making 29 August of that year, the centennial of Father Serra's burial, a legal holiday.

St. Junipero Serra was beatified in 1988 by Pope St. John Paul II and canonized by Pope Francis on Sept. 23, 2015.

Hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Hoy compartiré con ustedes una breve biografía de San Junípero Serra. Junípero fue canonizado en septiembre, durante la visita del Papa a Estados Unidos. Fue el primer santo canonizado en suelo estadounidense.

San Junípero Serra nació en 1713 en España, hijo de Antonio Nadal Serra y Margarita Rosa Ferrer, y recibió el nombre de Miguel José. A los 16 años ingresó en la Orden Franciscana. Asistió a la docencia de filosofía antes de su ordenación sacerdotal y posteriormente recibió el título de Doctor en Teología.

Por petición propia, fue asignado a una misión en México. Sirvió allí durante nueve años, aprendió la lengua de los indígenas pames y tradujo el catecismo a su lengua. Se hizo famoso como un predicador de misiones ferviente y eficaz. En 1767 fue nombrado superior de un grupo de quince franciscanos para las Misiones de la Baja California. En 1769, acompañó una expedición a la Alta California. Fundó la primera de las veintiuna misiones de California que lograron la conversión de los nativos de la costa. Las establecidas por el Padre Serra o durante su administración fueron San Carlos; San Antonio; San Gabriel; San Luis Obispo; San Francisco de Asís; San Juan Capistrano; Santa Clara; San Buenaventura. También estuvo presente en la fundación de Santa Bárbara.

En 1778 recibió la facultad de administrar el sacramento de la Confirmación. Visitó de nuevo las misiones desde San Diego hasta San Francisco, a lo largo de seiscientas millas, para confirmar a todos los bautizados. Sufría intensamente por una pierna paralizada y el pecho, pero no usaba remedios. Confirmó a 5309 personas. Sus virtudes eran la fortaleza, el celo, el amor a la mortificación, la abnegación y la confianza absoluta en Dios.

En 1884, la Legislatura de California aprobó una resolución concurrente que declaró el 29 de agosto de ese año, centenario del entierro del Padre Serra, como día festivo. San Junípero Serra fue beatificado en 1988 por el Papa San Juan Pablo II y canonizado por el Papa Francisco el 23 de septiembre de 2015.
