FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK/DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PASTOR

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In the Catholic Church the month of November is dedicated to remembering those who have died especially the poor souls in purgatory (those who have no one to pray for them). The Catechism of the Catholic Church states, "All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven" (1030).

For this reason, the Church has honored the memory of the dead by prayers of intercession for them. The Holy Mass is considered the most effective way to help the souls in purgatory. Holy Mass is the highest act of worship and the highest form of prayer. Saint Thomas Aquinas said, "As dew refreshes and raises up the withering plants and flowers, so does the Blood of Christ revive, comfort and bring renewed hope to the Poor Souls in Purgatory."

While there are many prayers for the dead and in particular for the poor souls here are a couple that you may wish to use:

"Eternal Father, I offer Thee the most Precious Blood of Jesus, with all the Masses being said all over the world this day, for the Souls in Purgatory." (Prayer of St. Gertrude)

Eternal rest grant unto them, O lord. And let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen. May the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen. (From the Funeral Rite)

Hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

En la Iglesia Católica, el mes de noviembre está dedicado a recordar a los que han muerto, especialmente a las pobres almas del purgatorio (aquellas que no tienen a nadie que rece por ellas). El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica declara: "Todos los que mueren en la gracia y amistad de Dios, pero aún imperfectamente purificados, tienen ciertamente asegurada su salvación eterna; pero después de la muerte se purifican, a fin de alcanzar la santidad necesaria para entrar en el gozo del cielo" (1030).

Por esta razón, la Iglesia ha honrado la memoria de los difuntos con oraciones de intercesión por ellos. La Santa Misa es considerada la forma más efectiva de ayudar a las almas en el purgatorio. La Santa Misa es el acto más elevado de adoración y la forma más elevada de oración. Santo Tomás de Aquino dijo: "Así como el rocío refresca y levanta las plantas y flores marchitas, así la Sangre de Cristo revive, consuela y trae esperanza renovada a las Pobres Almas del Purgatorio".

Si bien hay muchas oraciones por los muertos y, en particular, por las pobres almas, aquí hay un par que puede desear usar:

"Padre Eterno, Te ofrezco la Preciosísima Sangre de Jesús, con todas las Misas que se dicen en todo el mundo en este día, por las Almas del Purgatorio." (Oración de Santa Gertrudis)

Concédele, Señor, el descanso eterno. Y brille para él (ella) la luz perpetua. Descanse en paz. Amén. El alma de N. y las almas de todos los fieles difuntos, por la misericordia de Dios, descansen en paz. Amén. (Del Ritual de Exequias Cristianas)
