Dear Parents,

As your child prepares to enter Kindergarten this fall, here are a few ways you can support a smooth and confident transition over the summer:

1. Encourage your child to practice writing their name on lined paper. Please remind them to use a capital letter for the first letter only, with all remaining letters in lowercase.
2. Review the letters of the alphabet together.
3. Practice recognizing and counting numbers up to 20.
4. Research shows that children who read for at least 10 minutes each day develop stronger reading skills.

We recommend working with your child every day to help keep their skills fresh and build confidence.
