Dr. Chris Ojeih is the Chief Medical Officer and Medical Director at Alief Geriatrics Associates. He is board certified in Family Medicine with Geriatrics Fellowship Training. He obtained his Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery degree from the University of Ibadan/University College Hospital Ibadan in Nigeria. He practiced as a general practitioner and surgeon in Nigeria before relocating to the United States where he completed the Family Practice residency training at the University of Texas-Houston Health Science Center/Lyndon B.
