Dear Families and Friends of St Dominic Village,

To not be able to visit and to physically see and hug your loved one is incredibly hard, and at this time I am not sure when we will be able to relax some of our guidelines.

The policies that we are now following here at St Dominic Village are done for the health and safety of our residents and staff, but also from guidance issued by The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), and The Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC). It is my belief that as our city and state get back to a sense of normal, that we here at SDV will follow our new policies for much longer.

As of today, we do not have any cases of COVID-19 at our facility with either our residents or staff. And I want to assure all of you that if that changed you as the responsible party of a resident here at SDV would be one of the first to know. If we had even one case of the Coronavirus, we would inform all our families. Our prayer and hope is that St. Dominic Village does not encounter this horrible disease, but we are prepared for COVID-19 with training, PPE and isolation rooms if it is something that we faced.

I want to encourage all of you to continue to call and send notes and cards to your loved ones. If you need our assistance in calling or reaching out to your loved one, I would like to suggest that you call the facility receptionist to coordinate having your resident call you back. So often our nurses and nursing assistants are on the floor helping with resident care issues and they are not at the desk to answer the phones.
