I am happy to report that we have had two of our three vaccine clinics, and have vaccinated a great majority of our residents and staff. Even though we are still required to maintain the same level of PPE use and infection control precautions, and visitation rules have not changed, it is a step forward and for that we are very grateful!

I hope that 2021 brings much health and happiness to everyone that is a part of the St. Dominic Village family, and that soon we can all be together again on this campus.

VISITATION AT SDV

Many continue to ask the question when can we visit? **Nursing Center:**

Each level of care has different restrictions based on State guidelines and St. Dominic Village Policy. Any visitor to the campus regardless of the level of care MUST first check in at the check point inside the nursing center. To enter a building you MUST have on a facemask and if you need a different level of mask we will inform you and provide this for you. Here is the breakdown for each level of care:

Independent Living:

- Residents may have no more than one visitor at a time. These visits must take place in the resident's apartment.

Assisted Living:

- Residents may have only Essential Caregiver visits or closed window visits.

- Residents may have only Essential Caregiver visits or closed window visits.

Essential Caregiver visitors are 2 visitors assigned by the resident or responsible party to be the only visitors that can enter to visit a resident. They must provide a negative COVID test, wear proper PPE and go through training in order to visit. These visits are done by appointment only and can last no more than 2 hours. Visitors will be escorted to and from the resident's room, and can only visit one at a time.
